

Scholarships for Study Abroad and Beyond (Undergraduate)

U.S. Government Sponsored Scholarships for Study Abroad:

Gilman Scholarship: Up to \$4000 for study abroad over 4 weeks in duration. Students who receive a Pell Grant are eligible for this scholarship; for more information, go to <http://www.iie.org/Programs/Gilman-Scholarship-Program>. **Deadline on or around March 1 for summer and fall and October 1 for spring.**

Freeman-ASIA Scholarship: \$3000-\$7000 scholarships for study abroad in East or Southeast Asian countries and demonstrate financial need. For more information go to: <http://www.iie.org/Programs/Freeman-ASIA>.

Boren: Up to \$20,000 to study abroad for students interested in geographic areas, languages, and fields of study deemed critical to U.S. national security. Summer, semester, and full year funding available. For more info go to: www.borenawards.org

Critical Language Scholarship Program: The Critical Language Scholarship Program seeks participants from a variety of fields, backgrounds and career paths, with the goal of building a cadre of Americans who speak critical languages at high levels, in government, business, arts and culture, science and engineering, health and medicine, education, research and other fields. CLS is an overseas, group-based program that takes place each summer. Program costs – airfare, tuition, room and board, cultural program expenses, overseas health benefits, and applicable visa fees – are fully covered for all participants.
